Links for all live lessons will be located in the students' <i>Google Classroom</i> 				
Related Services	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Teleconference therapy sessions aligned to students' IEPs goals will be facilitated by the therapist based on the student's individual schedule. A combination of live Google Meets, Google assignments, phone calls and consultation are provided to each student. 				
Supported Employment	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Supported employment sessions aligned to the students' IEP will be facilitated by the job coach. A combination of live Google Meets, Google assignments, phone calls and consultation are provided for each student. 				
Paraprofessional Support	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Paraprofessionals, including 1:1 paraprofessionals, are available to work directly with students from 8:30 am – 3:00 pm through Google Classroom and Google Meets. Paraprofessionals will create daily Google Meets to be available for students. Paraprofessionals assist in presenting materials, providing accommodations, and demonstrating strategies in order for students to work on assignments Paraprofessionals are able to suggest behavioral supports for parents/guardians in order to help students be successful during virtual learning Under the supervision of the classroom teacher, paraprofessionals assist in developing materials to meet each student's unique needs 				
Student Work	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Student work is submitted via Google Classroom and emails directly to teachers/therapists Academic and therapeutic data is collected through permanent product, data sheets, anecdotal data, pictures and videos
